Admission Arrangements

(Reference will need to be made to the Academies admissions policy for specific entrance criteria)

Glenmoor and Winton Academies work in collaboration with the Local Authority for all admission arrangements. The Local Authority then act on the Academies behalf when applying the Academies admissions policy for allocation of student places which is reviewed annually.

Any questions or issues about the details listed below should be directed towards either the Local Authority Admissions team or Glenmoor and Winton Academies direct. All enquiries to the Academies will be responded to within 24 hours.

Applying for September 2017

To apply for your child to move up to secondary school in September 2017 the process begins on 1 September 2016.

There are talks being held at all schools with Year 5 classes throughout June. Representatives from the Council will be giving talks and answer any questions about moving up to secondary school. The schools have also been sent a leaflet to send to their parents of year 5 children.

Speak to your child's school to find out when their evening is being held or alternatively please contact the Academies to request a tour or attend one of our year 5 open mornings happening throughout the year.

If you've just moved to Bournemouth

If you have just moved to Bournemouth or are planning to in the near future, you should contact the Children's Information Service (CIS) for advice. Please note, school places can't normally be reserved more than half a term in advance.

In some cases, we need proof of your address. It may save time later if you provide this to the Local Authority with your application.

If you have moved to Bournemouth from overseas, you will also need to provide passports and visas (if applicable) for all members of the family before we can offer a place.

To apply for a place, you can complete the application form and return it to the Local Authority Admissions Services Team. We're happy to answer any questions you have. Just call the Children's Information Service on 01202 456223.

Applying for a school transfer during the academic year

If your child already attends a school in Bournemouth but you wish to move them to another within the Borough, then you will need to complete an application form and submit it to the Admissions Services Team.

The Local Authority and schools in Bournemouth operate a co-ordinated admissions process to enable there to be one application and one offer per pupil.
