Ofsted Inspection

As you may be aware, Ofsted visited Glenmoor Academy in December to carry out a routine, ungraded inspection. Following this, we are very pleased to inform you that the inspectors confirmed that the school has taken effective action to maintain the standards identified at the previous inspection, during which the school was judged 'Outstanding'. This is an excellent and highly deserved outcome for the school and a testament to the continuous hard work of students and staff alike.

In the inspectors' glowing report, students are praised for being "committed" and "successful in all areas of their learning". It is particularly gratifying that students are said to feel a "strong sense of belonging" and are "proud to attend" Glenmoor Academy. Equally, the inspectors commended the "high-quality curriculum" which ensures that students are "extremely well prepared for their future pathways".
