Re: Uniform and equipment

I would like to thank you for your continued support of the academies expectations surrounding our uniform and equipment standards. Following a successful start to the new term I thought it a pertinent time to remind you of expectations around this.

The girls' uniform consists of a branded blazer and skirt and an open necked white blouse which can be purchased from a variety of shops. The branded jumper is optional but it is the only jumper girls are permitted to wear. Shoes should be black leather with only a very small heel if desired. Our website provides more details on acceptable footwear and expectations. Our website also contains details of rules around our no make-up policy, hair style and colour, piercings and jewellery – please see the uniform requirements document under the 'policies' tab. These rules have not changed and I would imagine you are already familiar with them. The PE Kit consists of an academy logo polo shirt and navy shorts or skirt. Branded jumpers are optional but are the only jumpers students are permitted to wear. Various layers are permitted in the winter and again, our uniform policy on the website will give you more details on this.

Here at Glenmoor and Winton Academies, we take our uniform and equipment standards very seriously as we believe it is important that our students learn the importance of their personal appearance. Students who fail to wear correct uniform are sent to our isolation room where they will stay until the issue has been resolved.

A change that has occurred are our equipment expectations where all students must have the following items;

- Clear pencil case
- 2 black pens
- 2 pencils
- Sharpener
- Protractor
- 30cm ruler
- 2 green pens
- Highlighter
- Rubber
- Scientific calculator

At present a missing equipment item will result in a tick on your child's GW First Impressions card. I am delighted to say a majority of students are well equipped, however, please be aware that as of 1 October missing equipment will result in a same day detention.
